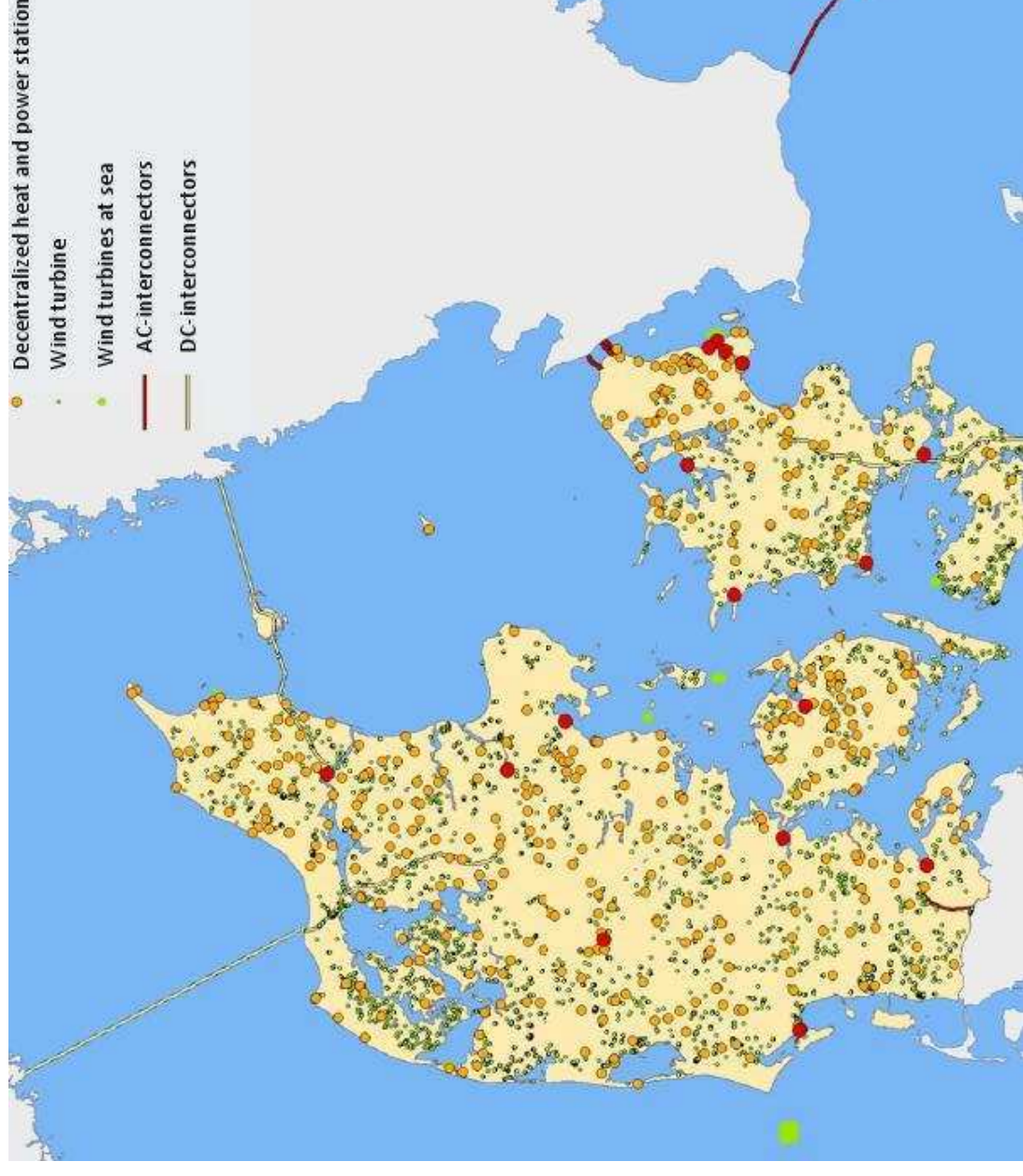
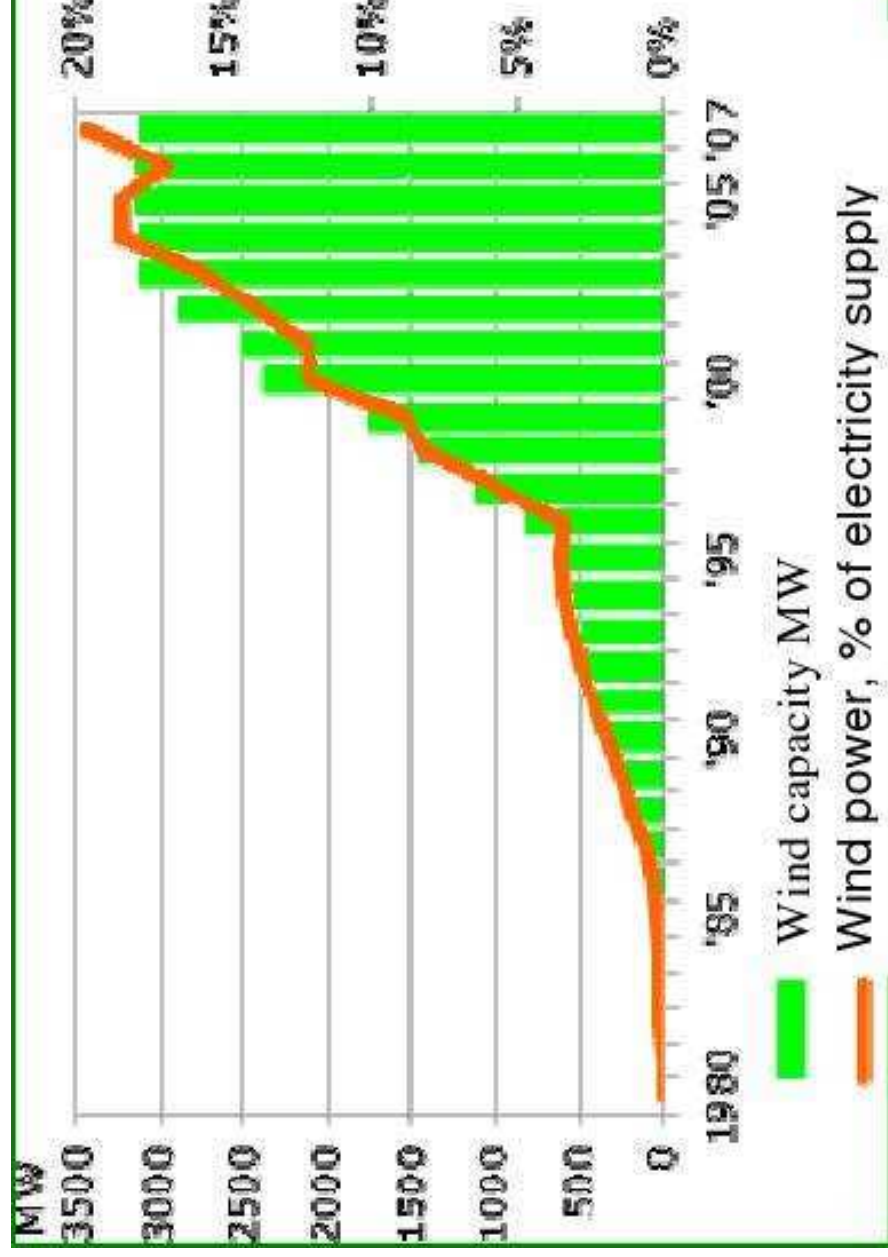


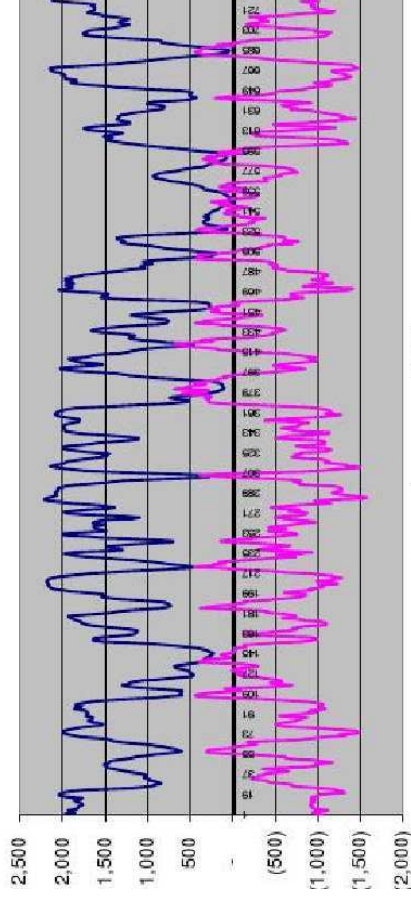

Danish Windmills production

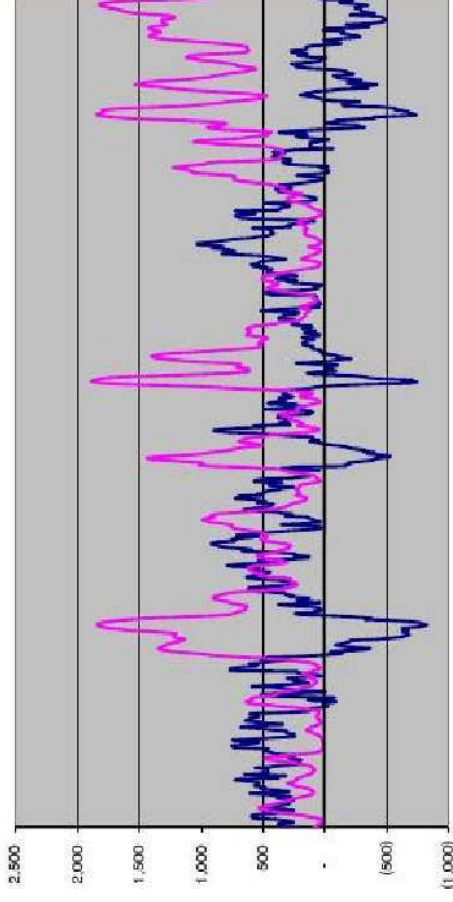


Exporting Wind electricity

Danish electricity exports are connected to wind, and one has estimated that 74% of the production is exported to Norway and Sweden. As these have a large electric power from dams (or storage hydroelectric plants: 90 and 40% hydroelectric generation resp.), they are able to incorporate the wind production of Denmark.
